- Support for the July 28th Our Children Our Future Civic Engagement Workshop at Monongalia General Hospital; the League of Women Voters was the lead sponsor.

The Shared Use Network, a collaboration of schools, community partners/organizations, parents and community members, is working with over 52 schools statewide and currently supporting over 80 schools to provide safe play areas for physical activity to their local residents.
- Planning underway for the Eleventh Martin Luther King, Jr., Day Celebration for January 16, 2017, with the theme of “Non-violence is Courageous.” The City of Morgantown has committed a maximum of \$1,500 for this event.
